What kind of repairs does Good Works do?



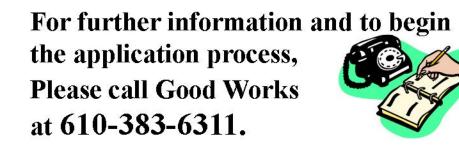
The repairs we do focus on making a home warmer, safer, and
