- Live in their home
- Live in the geographic boundaries in which we serve
- Participate on workdays as possible
- Have property taxes paid
- Meet our income guidelines



What kind of repairs does Good Works do?



The repairs we do focus on making a home **warmer, safer, and drier**. This may include roof repair, plumbing installation and repair, electrical rewiring and code compliance, heating installation and upgrades, insulation and drywall work, fire restoration and floor repair.



Good Works does not:

- Provide cash assistance for fuel, utilities, food or clothing
- Assist renters, churches, or businesses
