Enclosure 1: March 2025 Devotion The Testimony of the Tree Jeremiah 17:7-8

"But blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord whose confidence is in him. They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit."

Nothing heralds the return of springtime this month more than the trees. By the end of March, the cherry blossoms will be bursting forth in Washington, DC. Trees are one of God's most amazing creations. Did you know? Trees are the longest living organisms on Earth, and some species are biologically immortal. The oldest known tree is a Great Basin Bristlecone Pine that is over 5,000 years old. Trees can communicate with each other using a network of fungi called the "wood wide web". They can send signals about drought, disease, and insect attacks to each other. Other than people and God, trees are the most mentioned living thing in the Bible. There are trees in the first chapter of Genesis (verses 11–12), in the first psalm (Psalm 1:3), and on the last page of Revelation (22:2). As if to underscore all these trees, the Bible refers to wisdom as a tree (Proverbs 3:18).

All trees have another thing in common. Whether a young sapling or a mature, established tree, each grow in stature and girth via annular rings. These are the circular bands that form on a tree's trunk each year. The rings vary based on the environmental conditions experienced during the growing season, meaning factors like temperature and precipitation are the main drivers of a ring's width, with wider rings generally indicating favorable conditions (like wet, warm years) and narrow rings signifying stressful conditions (like drought, insect infestation or cold periods) during the tree's growth year. A tree's growth rings tell its story...its testimony.

When a tree is sacrificed for its wood, the rings become evident as lumber's grain. The grain of wood is a fundamental characteristic that affects the wood's strength, stability, appearance and workability. In the hands of a master carpenter, the wood's grain is revealed. He will cut, shape and finish it to accentuate the grain creating what we most admire in a fine piece of finished furniture.

The Bible reminds us that our lives should be like a tree planted by a river. We are blessed when we put our trust in the Lord and in His Word. We will be spiritually healthy, vibrant, and productive for the Kingdom of God when we take advantage of the endless supply of the wisdom from God's Word. God knows all about the seasons of our lives and how we responded in the warm, wet years as well as the cold, drought filled years. He knows our innermost thoughts and motivations of our heart.(Psalm 139:1) Thankfully, He sent Jesus to be our Master Carpenter recognizing that one day the grain of our lives will be revealed. What will our growth rings reveal? What are our stories? Are we becoming wood that the Master Craftsman can use or are we destined for the fireplace. The Good News is that Jesus can take a piece of warped, knotty pine or piece of rich dark ebony and create something beautiful with it. It is my prayer that the stories embedded deeply in your grain will reflect God's presence in your life.
