By the Book

1 John 5:3

For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome.

As contractors, it's essential that we follow proper procedures when building new, remodeling or even making simple repairs. Improperly performed construction projects by taking shortcuts, using low-quality materials or poor workmanship can lead to serious personal injury or property damage. This is especially true for tasks involving electricity, plumbing, or structural work. We need to do these repairs "by the book." Doing things "by the book" means completing a task according to the manufacturer's instructions, professional standards, or local building codes. This approach ensures the work is done safely and correctly—and helps preserve any applicable warranties. But if done incorrectly, unintentionally or not, the penalties can be harsh, including fines, costly repairs and even revocation of our contractor's license.

We know all this when it comes to construction, but the same principle applies in our lives. Our creator God has wired us to know the difference between right and wrong.
